Neighborhood Reminders

Trash & Recycle Cans:

All trash and recycle cans/bins need to be stored out of view from street. This can be accomplished by storing in your garage, behind landscape screening or a trash can enclosure screen. You will need to submit your proposed screen (landscape or enclosure) prior to installation. Per Town of Cary ordinances, trash receptacles should be placed by curb for pickup.

Outdoor Maintenance:

Homeownership requires upkeep in the home and landscape, especially in a deed restricted community. Please take the time to carefully look over the exterior of their home and lawn and assess its condition. Arrangements should be made now to attend to several maintenance issues that may currently

be in violation of our community standards. Please take the time to address the issues, or if you prefer, seek out vendors to assist in performing these tasks.

Take pride in your home and community by taking an inventory of the maintenance needs of your home and lawn and begin the process of scheduling and completing the work that is needed to remedy the maintenance requirements.

Items to check for:

Power washing exterior of homes

Examine entire house including eaves and the sides of home.

Call 919.461.0102. Omega has a responsive management team to take action for common area or amenity concerns and an after business hours or weekend on call manager.

Assess the situation:

Please call 911 if you see a fire or dangerous situation.

Please follow up with Omega to alert them of damages or concerns to common area or amenities.

The emergency line is not for personal property issues, speeding, or utility issues related to your personal property.

Outdoor maintenance cont.

Mailbox Maintenance

Check if repairs are needed on your mailbox. This includes post and mailbox; does it need repair or fresh paint, do the door and flag work correctly? Is the paint still bright, or is it faded by the sun? Can you read the numbers from a distance?

Trim Repairs

Are there shutters that need painting from fading? Have you checked the windows, eaves and louvers?

Fencing

May need power washing or repairs to posts. Check for leaning, detached pickets, missing gates or pickets, rotting boards, weeds and vines that need removal.

Lawn Maintenance

Keep lawns mowed, weeded, edged with driveways and sidewalks clear of yard debris such as lawn clippings. Refresh pine straw or mulch.

Weed Control

Many yards have weed control issues. Hire a lawn care professional if you need help. All Landscape beds and tree rings need to be weed free.
